Jack shared with the students how his life has been impacted by the gift that Kyle has given him. Carl Hunlock spoke about the importance of being aware of the choices that we make and how these choices can impact other people's lives.

Students also gained a better understanding of the facts of organ donation from Jackie Hines, spokesperson for the Life Line of Ohio as she shed light on the myths that hold people back from being an organ donor. Jackie also took time to answer many questions that students had on the subject.

Overall, the presentation made a tremendous impact on the students in Mr. Howe's health class. Not only did they leave with something to think about, but they were also inspired by the choices that Kyle Hunlock made in his lifetime.
